Who we are





Shaping the future

Through a strategic and initiative-taking approach to **#MakingBiogasHappen**, the WBA influences global policies and regulations, sets standards and provides knowledge exchange, to fast-track the development of AD and complementary technologies, open new markets and promote the industry's growth on both a global and regional scale. Our strategic approach includes:

- **Access to Networks:** Affording access to the largest global networks of expertise across multiple geographies, industries, political and financial institutions.
- **Advocacy and Standards:** Proactively supporting and collaborating with member National Associations in lobbying national and regional governments and developing a universal framework of standards, aligned to training and data collection protocols, in support of a rapid roll-out of a high performing industry.
- **Integrated Campaigns:** Initiating integrated political and industry campaigns through the publication of landmark reports, market intelligence, data analysis and political initiatives, such as the Paris Declaration (lodged with the UNFCCC).
- **Knowledge Exchange and Thought Leadership:** Delivering knowledge exchange and thought leadership through a tiered engagement approach, including Members' Meetings, Working Groups, Sector Interest Groups and Roundtables, to open and advance new markets and advise on operational best practice and policy/finance mechanisms.
- **Global Events:** Co-hosting the annual World Biogas Summit & Expo, the largest global event dedicated to AD and biogas, a platform for networking, showcasing industry advancements and fostering collaboration on a global scale.
- **Country-Specific Programmes:** Organising and hosting the World Biogas Congress Series, a programme of country-specific events in partnership with National Associations and key industry partners, supporting countries in developing roadmaps for the adoption, scaling up and professionalisation of the biogas industry.
- **Promotion:** The WBA promotes the value of the biogas industry to national and global policymakers by addressing legislative and regulatory issues affecting scale up. Member working groups inform the WBA positioning on these strategically important international forums.

#MakingBiogasHappen

By recycling the 105 billion tonnes of organic wastes generated by human activity every year, we can stop the immense pollution and climate change impact they have by turning them into valuable products to support countries' energy and food security and contribute to the development of a global bioeconomy.

To accelerate this development, the WBA has pioneered **#MakingBiogasHappen** - a landmark international initiative which will serve as the industry blueprint to:

- Benchmark minimum operating standards and performance indicators across the design, build and operation of AD plants.
- Empower governments and regulators to adopt the frameworks necessary to ensure all collectable organic wastes are recycled through AD.
- Integrate data analytics across the technology and performance of AD plants to provide evidence against benchmark environmental KPIs.
- Deliver a data strategy which allows the industry blueprint to be adopted into national bioenergy plans and secure evidence for countries (and companies) to optimise revenues from carbon pricing regimes.
- Deliver a comprehensive education, information and training platform to develop a professionalised workforce and facilitate rapid integration into the AD industry of workers migrating from sectors such as oil and gas.
